

CREATING YOUR WIKI PAGES

As a group you are responsible for authoring a Wiki page for your assigned topic. I have provided you some guidance on what your topic should cover, but ultimately you will plan, research, and create your own ideas. Ensure to carefully select relevant material (Stay on Topic)!

RESEARCH, RESEARCH, and more RESEARCH

You are to become an expert on your topic by searching and evaluating all available information available to you. Remember to follow copyright guidelines and ensure you are creating with your own words. If you use someone else's work, than make sure you give them credit. You can either cite the source, or use a link to direct other users on where you obtained the info.

Communication Clearly (Organization, and Presentation)

- Information is easily understood
- Your Wiki page is visually appealing
- Graphics are relevant and support your text
- Use a range of 2.0 tools that add interest to your topic(widgets, links, video, etc)

Collaborate and Work Together

- ✓ Communicate with team members frequently.
- ✓ All members need to provide feedback and contribute ideas for the project.
- ✓ All team members need to participate fully, and encourage others to participate
- ✓ Be Considerate of one another and remember our class agreements

REFLECTION AND EVALUATION

WIKI WIZARD TIPS

FORMAT

- ★ Lots of space between paragraphs
- ★ Clear and deliberate headings in large, bold font
- ★ Bullets to organize lists of information
- ★ Less writing on more pages - links, links, links!
- ★ Images to break up the page

EDITING/CREATING

- ★ USE SMALL EDITS
- ★ REFRESH BEFORE WRITING
- ★ USE THE HISTORY
- ★ DISCUSS AND WORK TOGETHER
- ★ COMMUNICATE CLEARLY
- ★ MAKE USE OF THE TOOLS AVAILBLE <http://help.wikispaces.com/>
- ★ ORGANIZE YOUR PAGE
- ★ USE LINKS TO DIRECT READERS TO ADDITIONAL INFO, OR TO CITE YOUR WORK

REFLECT AND EVALUATE

- ★ CONTENT (CLARITY, QUALITY, QUANTITY)
- ★ COMMUNICATION (WORK AS COLLABORATORS)
- ★ DESIGN (LAYOUT, USE OF GRAPHICS, OVERALL DESIGN)
